TRAVEL TIPS

- Take the Great Brak River turn-off from the N2 and turn right if travelling from George, left if travelling from Mossel Bay.
- Drive through Great Brak River for 1.9 km where you will find a church at the third stop on your left.
- Turn left into Amy Searle Street (museum on your left).
- Keep straight in the direction of Friemersheim. Expect road works until 2020 (week days only) from Hakuna Matata to Friemersheim.
- Kobus Halliday Car Museum: Turn left in Sorgfontein Road, the first gravel road (Hilltop Farm Stall on your right). OR travel along the R102 parallel to the N2, and turn right into Sorgfontein Road (Leani Kwekery on your right). Road works until 2020, week days only, to commence soon.
- If you turn off at Kleinlei you will travel on gravel via The Village Lodge to Friemersheim - great for game viewing and cycling. Check on the day whether the road is open between Friemersheim and The Village Lodge.
